

Application for International Appendix Registration

- Appendix registration is available to horses registered with an APHA-recognized international Paint Horse registry. Appendix registration indicates an intent to use a stallion or mare in a breeding program designed to produce offspring eligible for APHA registration with full privileges. Registration of a gelding in the Appendix Registry would be for performance purposes only.
- Horses registered in the Appendix Registry are granted the appropriate level of appendix designation based upon APHA-approved bloodlines within their pedigree. All horses registered with an APHA recognized international registry will be eligible for a minimum of 50 percent APHA Appendix registered (F1). Higher levels may be granted based upon pedigree.

Pedigree Information

- Submit a photocopy (front and back) of your current international registry registration certificate.
- Pedigree information must be a copy of a certified pedigree from an official international registry certificate that includes five generations. It should include all available American registration names and numbers, color and pattern type (if applicable). If the copy of international registry registration certificate does not include five generation pedigree information please submit on a separate page.

Photographs

- A current set of four photographs should be provided. Include direct left sideview, direct right sideview, direct front and direct rear to use for identification purposes.

Membership

- An APHA membership is required. You may purchase it at this time.
- Memberships are issued in the exact same name as the name under which the horse is owned. Memberships begin the same month the registration application is postmarked.

Rush Fees

- Average registration completion times range from two to 14 weeks, depending on time of year submitted. If you wish to have your registration completed sooner, a rush service is available. Following is required on rush work:
 1. Envelope marked "RUSH"
 2. Daytime phone number
 3. Fax number or email address
 4. Only certified funds or a credit card will be accepted
- The rush fee will not be refunded.
- Minimum processing time for a rush registration is 10 working days from date received.

Appendix Registration of International Registered Horses

Appendix registration is available to horses registered with an APHA-recognized international Paint Horse registry. Appendix registration indicates an intent to use a stallion or mare in a breeding program designed to produce offspring eligible for APHA registration with full privileges. Registration of a gelding in the Appendix Registry would be for performance purposes only.

Horses registered in the Appendix Registry are granted the appropriate level of appendix designation based upon APHA-approved bloodlines within their pedigree. All horses registered with an APHA recognized international registry will be eligible for a minimum of 50 percent APHA Appendix registered (F1). Higher levels may be granted based upon pedigree.

To apply for appendix registration of your horse, the following requirements must be met:

- The horse must first be registered with an international registry that has been approved by APHA.
- An application for appendix registration must be completed and signed by the recorded owner (as recorded in the official records of the international registry). Forms are available from the APHA office.
- A photocopy, front and back, of the international registry registration certificate must be provided.
- Current photographs of the horse applying for appendix registration must be submitted. The photographs must include a left side view, right side view, front and rear.
- Remittance of the appendix registration fee.

Upon completion of processing, the recorded owner will receive an Appendix certificate issued by APHA. International Appendix-registered horses are not eligible to compete in APHA-approved shows (unless specifically intended for International Appendix registered horses) and can only be advertised as “APHA Appendix-registered.” However, International Appendix registered horses are eligible to participate in APHA programs such as Paint Alternative Competition.

If a horse has been previously appendix-registered and ownership changes, the new owner must submit a photocopy of the international registry certificate showing that the ownership change has been properly recorded in the international registry and submit the fee for updating the ownership.

WHAT IS DOUBLE-REGISTRATION? Eligibility for double-registration is provided to a filly upon reaching F3, or a colt resulting from the breeding of an F3 stallion and an APHA registered/recognized mare. Double-registration provides full privileges of APHA registration.

The chart below shows the process through which a breeding program can evolve to produce foals eligible for full APHA registration.
