ATTENTION AMATEUR AND NOVICE EXHIBITORS

Any horse exhibited at APHA approved shows or shows sponsored by the APHA, or to qualify for the various APHA Amateur points, titles and awards, the Amateur or the Amateur's family must be the current recorded owner of the horse. Family shall include the following: spouse, mother, father, son, daughter, brother, sister, grandchild, grandparent, step-grandparent, legal ward, inlaws (father, mother, brother, sister, son, daughter), stepchild, stepparent, stepbrother, stepsister, half brother, half sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, or solely owned corporation, ranch or farm. Such ownership must be evidence by the records of the APHA.

AM-020.B. TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP

The exhibitor must be able to prove ownership at the time of the show by presenting the APHA registration certificate or a legible photocopy with the correct owner or owner's name printed on the certificate by the APHA office.
