Application to Host an APHA-approved Trail Ride

Are you looking for the perfect opportunity to see some of the most beautiful countryside from the back of your horse? Are you interested in fulfilling your club charter requirements at the same time?

If so, let APHA walk you through the process of hosting your own trail ride.

At the 2003 APHA Annual Convention, an amendment to the club charter requirements was made to allow clubs to host trail rides in lieu of or in combination with shows. The requirements were later modified to allow current members (individuals or entities) to also host an approved ride.

To begin this process, please fill out this application completely and return it to the American Paint Horse Association with the \$25 application fee. Upon receipt of the application to APHA, you will receive promotion of your ride in various APHA media (depending on production deadlines). A how-to booklet on hosting trail rides is available on the APHA website containing guidelines and forms. These guidelines must be followed for a trail ride to qualify as an APHA approved Trail Ride. A Few Points to Remember for Sponsoring an APHA Approved Trail Ride

- The ride must be coordinated by a regional club, member or entity in good standing with the APHA.
- The trail ride coordinator must be an APHA member in good standing.
- The ride dates must be approved by APHA.
- The ride must have a minimum of 10 riders to qualify as a recognized ride.
- The ride must be open to all breeds, horse or mule.
- The ride must consist of a minimum of two (2) hours ride time.
- There will be no limits on distance from other APHA approved trail rides or shows on the same dates.
- Insurance and liability are recommended and are the responsibility of the ride sponsor.
- The ride sponsor should obtain written permission of the landowner if the ride is to be held on private property. Proper permits must be obtained if the ride is to be held on state or federal land.
- The ride sponsor must secure a liability release and registration form from each rider\non-rider.*
