



Meredith Landy has been involved in showing paint horses since the early 1970s. As a teenager, she served as the third President of the American Junior Paint Horse Association and today she is on the board of directors of the American Paint Horse Foundation, the non-profit arm of APHA that focuses on educational scholarships and preservation of the breed's heritage.

Meredith has been a perennial all-around competitor, having won world and reserve world titles in a wide range of events, including hunter under saddle, western pleasure, trail, western riding and pleasure driving. She has been #1 on the honor roll in showmanship, pleasure driving and hunter under saddle and has consistently appeared on the amateur and masters Top 20. She still actively competes today in APHA and sees no end in sight to her show career. Her 10-year old daughter Ashlyn has joined Meredith on the show circuit, making it now a family affair.

Meredith is a retired attorney now raising her two daughters in Winchester, California. She was formerly an equity partner at the law firm of O'Melveny & Myers LLC where she headed the firm's litigation group in Silicon Valley and served as the head of the firm's securities litigation group in Asia and Silicon Valley. Meredith served as a member of the Vestry at Trinity Episcopal Church in Menlo Park, California, and later served on Session at Grace Presbyterian Church in Temecula, California. She has now started her own breeding operation, French Valley Farms LLC, which is devoted to breeding, raising and selling high quality APHA all-around prospects.
