2024 BREEDERS' TRUST PLEASURE STAKES CONDITIONS



3-Year-Old Pleasure Stakes Eligibility and Entry Requirements

- Horses must be nominated to the Breeders' Trust to be eligible.
 - All Breeders' Trust-nominated horses (Regular Registry and Solid Paint-Bred) are eligible to enter the APHA Breeders' Trust Pleasure Stakes.
- Entry Fees:
 - o 2- year-old year Postmarked November 15, 2023 \$1,500 enrollment payment
 - Late Enrollment Fee Period 1–
 Postmarked November 16, 2023 December 31, 2023
 \$3,000 enrollment payment
 - Late Enrollment Fee Period 2-Postmarked January 1, 2024 - 5:00 p.m. the day before the class \$4,500 enrollment payment
 - o 3-year-old year 1st Open Class Entry Payment- Postmarked April 15, 2024 –\$725 (includes \$225 admin. fee)
 - o 3-year-old year 2nd Open Class Entry Payment- Postmarked June 1, 2024–\$500
 - Late Entry Fee If the 1st entry payment is missed through 5 p.m. the day before the class \$1,500 + \$225 admin fee
 - *If entering both 3-year-old Open classes, an additional \$1,000 entry fee will apply.*
 - o Total investment = \$2,500/enrollment and entry + \$225 admin. fee

Classes:

- o 3-Year-Old Western Pleasure and 3-Year-Old Hunter Under Saddle
- o A combined \$50,000 purse will be split based on the number of entries in each class. \$5,000 added per class guaranteed.
- Offered with a limited and a maiden horse division as a class within a class.
- o Payout 75% Open / 12.5% Limited/ 12.5% Maiden Horse
- o Both classes are eligible for NSBA dual approval with payment of the applicable fee.

 Horses eligible also for the Breeders' Trust Non-Pro 3-Year-Old Western Pleasure Stakes and/or the Breeders' Trust Non-Pro 3-Year-Old Hunter Under Saddle Stakes classes. Additional entry fees apply.

• 2024 Maiden Horse Eligibility Criteria:

Horse must be declared they are eligible for the Maiden Division when the second entry payment is due June 1st.

—A Maiden Horse cannot have been shown astride before the start of the class entered at the 2024 APHA World Show.

• 2024 Limited Exhibitor Eligibility Criteria:

Exhibitor must declare they are eligible for the Limited Division by 5 P.M. the day before the class by completing the Limited Division section of the entry form.

- —A Limited Rider is a rider that has not earned the following as of January 1 of the show year:
 - An APHA Open World Champion, Open Reserve World Champion, Challenge Champion, Reserve Challenge Champion, Breeders' Trust Pleasure Stakes Champion or Reserve title between 2021-2023 in the same discipline in which they are exhibiting.
 - The Limited Champion or Reserve Limited Champion of the Breeders' Trust 3-Year-Old Pleasure Stakes classes will not be eligible to compete as a Limited exhibitor the following year in the same discipline in which they are exhibiting.
 - Earned an AQHA Open World or Reserve World Champion title between 2021–2023 in the same discipline in which they are exhibiting.
 - Must be eligible for corresponding NSBA Limited Division.

All Amateur and Youth are eligible (please see all eligibility criteria listed above). All Amateurs must own/lease their horse to be eligible to compete. Youth are not required to own/lease their horse to be eligible to compete.

Payouts:

- All fees are non-refundable. Administrative fees retained by APHA.
- All payments received will be paid out as follows:
 - o \$1,250 per enrollment will be paid out in the 3-Year-Old Open classes
 - o \$250/horse will be carried over to Non-Pro 3-Year-Old Stakes class purses.
- All remaining payments, including partial and late payments, will be paid out during the 3-year-old year and split per class based on the total number of horses entered.
- Class purses split 75% to Open Division, 12.5% to Limited Division, 12.5% to Maiden Horse Division.
- 3-Year-Old Open Purse \$5,000 minimum added guaranteed per class.

Non-Pro 3-Year-Old Eligibility and Entry Requirements

- Horse must have been enrolled into the Breeders' Trust Pleasure Stakes program by paying the applicable enrollment fee.
- Horses can be shown in the Breeders' Trust Non-Pro 3-Year-Old Western Pleasure Stakes and/or the Breeders' Trust Non-Pro 3-Year-Old Hunter Under Saddle Stakes class.
- Must be shown by a non-pro (Amateur or Youth exhibitor). Horse must be owned/leased by Amateur/Youth and/or the Amateur/Youth's family member. See rules AM-020 and YP-015 for complete ownership/lease requirements.
- \$800 Entry Fee required; \$400 first payment by April 15 and second payment by June 1 (85% of entry fee jackpotted into purse).
- Both classes are eligible for NSBA dual approval with payment of the applicable fee.
- APHA will guarantee \$7,000 in combined total added money (combined overall and split based on entries) for 2024.
- All fees listed above are per class. Additional fees will be required if entering both Western Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle classes in a given year.
