Scope

90 - 100	Excellent equitation, position and presentation; meets all fences squarely and at proper distance. Uses all options to their advantage.
80 - 89	Minor equitation faults, i.e., long weak distance deep distance, one step landing at counter canter. Exhibitor still maintains a quality ride.
70 - 79	More problems occur, equitation suffers. i.e., rounded shoulders, heels are not down, hands incorrect, lacks the style and presence. One major fence problem, i.e., chip with a ride up the neck, discreet swap out or jumping off one side of jump. No dangerous fences, but not a flowing course.

60 - 69	Major equitation faults, poor body position, loose legs and seat, failure to obtain or maintain trot to a trot fence approach, 2 or 3 misses at the fence.
40 - 59	Breaking to a trot while on course, counter canter or cross canter ends of arena, missed lead changes, loss of stirrup, drop a rein, extra stride in combination.
10 - 39	Exhibitor avoids elimination, one or two refusals, knock-downs, dangerous fences.
