GRAND/RESERVE CHAMPIONS	It is mandatory that all approved APHA shows select Grand and Reserve Grand Champions in each sex division. APHA will note the title of Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion on the performance record ONLY when at least 3 horses (yearling and older) are exhibited in a sex division. Mandatory Classes

SC-095.A.5. Solid Paint Bred (see Rule SC-325.K)

a. Six halter classes and b. Three performance classes

- 1. at least 2 mare classes**
- 2. at least 2 gelding classes**
- 3. at least 2 stallion classes**

NOTE: The APHA show processing fee is \$1 per entry per judge for all show types.

Weanlings are ineligible for the color classes.

YOUTH SHOWING STALLIONS: A youth must be at least 16 years of age to exhibit a stallion in open classes. SC-160.A.2.

LESS THAN TWO (2) HORSES PER CLASS:

No class of less than two (2) horses shall receive points, but all classes, regardless of number of entries shall be judged.

CLERICAL CORRECTIONS ON JUDGES CARDS:

If clerical corrections, initiated by show official(s) (typically the announcer, but could also be the show secretary or manager) are made to a judge's card, they must be approved and INITIALED BY THE JUDGE.

Any horse that is disqualified or has a no score should be noted with an exhibitor number (if 7 or less in the class).

SECRETARIES MUST OFFER TEMPORARY AMATEUR, NOVICE AMATEUR, AMATEUR WALK-TROT, YOUTH, NOVICE YOUTH AND YOUTH WALK-TROT 11-18 TEMPORARY CARDS AS WELL AS TEMPORARY APHA MEMBERSHIPS AND EXHIBITOR CARDS. JUDGE CARD INFORMATION

Please sort by judge, then by halter, then performance and band each set of judge cards together. Do not put ancillary judge cards with the main judge cards. Each set of judge cards should be sorted separately.

MULTIPLE JUDGE SHOWS:

An entry in a multiple-judged show will be considered an entry under all judges and show fees will be assessed accordingly.

If there is a conflict, they must still enter under all judges. That judge should record "CONFLICT" of interest on his/her judge's cards.

Those conflicted entries still count as an entry in the total number of entries in the class.

VERIFY RELATIONSHIPS OF EXHIBITORS TO OWNERS IN YOUTH AND AMATEUR CLASSES

Always verify the relationship between each owner when the horse is jointly owned. Do not list the relationship as "self".

The Amateur exhibitor must be related to each name listed on the horse's registration
