



# 2024 International Ranch Horse Association World Championship Show

The International Ranch Horse Association World Championship Show, held in conjunction with the APHA World Championship Show, offers IRHA world championship classes in open, non-pro and youth divisions in addition to the Ranch Horse Triple Crown Challenge and IRHA Ranch Horse Futurity.

- 3 Divisions: Open, Non-Pro, Youth
- 3 Events in Each Division: Ranch Riding / Ranch Trail / Ranch Rail
  - All Ranch Riding and Ranch Trail classes are held concurrently with the Ranch Horse Triple Crown Challenge classes.
  - Ranch Rail classes are held as standalone classes.
  - All classes are judged in accordance with APHA rules.
- This event is open to ALL-BREEDS. Any horse three years of age or older is eligible.
- NO QUALIFYING required.
- Non-Pro Eligibility:
  - Exhibitor must be a youth (18 years of age or younger as of January 1) or an amateur/non-pro with a current and valid amateur/non-pro card held with any recognized equine association including, but not limited to APHA, AQHA, ApHC, IBHA, ABRA, PHBA, PtHA, NRHA, NRCHA, NCHA and SHTX.
  - All horses entered in the Non-Pro division must be owned/leased by the non-pro exhibitor or an immediate family member only in accordance with APHA and AQHA immediate family rules by 5 p.m. the day prior to the class in which the horse is to be exhibited in their respective classes.
- Youth Eligibility:
  - Exhibitor must be a youth (18 years of age or younger as of January 1).
  - All horses entered in the Youth division must be owned/leased by the youth exhibitor or an immediate family member only in accordance with APHA and AQHA immediate family rules by 5 p.m. the day prior to the class in which the horse is to be exhibited in their respective classes.
  - Youth are also eligible to enter the Non-Pro division. Additional entry fees apply.
- No additional membership fees required.
- Each competitor is limited to five (5) horses shown per class, except Rail where only one (1) horse may be shown.
- Entry Deadline & Fees:
  - All entries, stall and RV reservations must be submitted online or postmarked by May 15, 2024 in order to pay pre-entry fees. Entries accepted up until 5 p.m. the day before the class, but late fees apply.

- Individual Class Awards:
  - World Championship trophy buckles awarded to all class Champions and Reserve Champions.
  - Payouts
  - Special awards presented to the top 10 in each class.
- **Payouts - Sponsored by Markel**
  - \$1,000 added per class guaranteed.
  - Payouts consist of 55% of class entry fees (excluding equipment/schooling fee if applicable and all late fees) plus sponsored added money.
  - Payouts awarded based on the APHA World Show payout schedule outlined in the premium book. Total payout per class is based on the number of paid entries per class.
