Entry Fees: \$32.00/class or Max \$160.00/horse Youth Lead Line—Free

Practice Trail - Each Trail horse will be charged \$10 mandatory

Practice Over Fence – Each over fence horse will be charged \$10 mandatory

Reining: \$\$All Amateur & Open will be Jackpotted (included in entry fee) \$47 per class (\$10 jackpot + \$5 to PPHSS finals)

Cattle Classes: \$\$All Amateur & Open will be Jackpotted (included in entry fee)

Roping & Working Cowhorse \$47 per class (Jackpot \$10 + PPHSS \$5) + cattle charge Cutting \$57 per class (Jackpot \$20 + PPHSS \$5) + cattle charge

Crossover Fee: Once a horse has maxed out in a division (paid the \$80 all day fee), that horse may

ELIMINATED crossover to **ALL** eligible divisions with no additional entry fee (TSCC fee only)

Office/APHA Fees: \$32.00/horse

TSCC Fee: \$.50/class/Judge = \$2 per class

Stall/Grounds Fees: \$20.00/horse/day

1. Age Groups: Performance Horses – Jr. Ages 5 & Under Performance Horses – Sr. Ages 6 & Over

Youth & Amateur - Exhibitor's age as of Jan 1, 2009

Youth & Amateur Exhibitors must provide age on entry form

- 2. Each exhibitor <u>MUST</u> show a current APHA membership card to the show secretary. A replacement membership card may be purchased at the show.
- 3. <u>Novice Amateurs and Amateurs MUST</u> show 2009 Amateur Card to show secretary at each show and cannot show horses that they do not own in accordance with APHA Rule AM-020.A. **Must have copy of transferred papers in hand to show.** Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
- 4. Novice Youth MUST show 2009 card to show secretary at each show. (YP-210). Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
- 5. TPHC Show All Around Qualifications:

<u>Open All-Around Horse</u> – To qualify for this award, horse must be shown in Open halter and 3 performance events in 3 different categories. (Rule SC-145.A)

<u>Walk-Trot/Youth/Novice Youth/Novice Amateur/Amateur All Around</u>— To qualify for these awards, horse/rider combination must be shown in <u>respective halter</u> class and 3 performance events.
