



Hall of Fame Nomination Form - Horse

Hall of Fame Criteria

1. Inductee must be a registered American Paint Horse.
2. Anyone can nominate a horse for the Hall of Fame by submitting the form below to the American Paint Horse Foundation office.
3. Nominees will be screened by the APHF Hall of Fame Selection Committee based on the following criteria:
 3. Selection should parallel the horse's involvement in APHA chronologically.
 4. The horse should be selected based on the enjoyment and excitement they have provided competitors and spectators alike either through their own accomplishments or those of their offspring.
4. Selection to the Hall of Fame should never be used to promote or publicize a particular bloodline for commercial gain, but rather to honor the contribution to the enjoyment and improvement of the breed.
5. Deadline for the next year's nominations is December 1 of each year, and a final slate of recommended candidates will be presented to the APHF Board by the Hall of Fame Selection Committee. New inductees will be approved by the APHF Board and the APHA Executive Committee and will be announced in July and presented with an bronze trophy at the annual awards banquet, held during the subsequent APHA convention. The APHF Heritage Committee will make every attempt to gather any pertinent memorabilia, photographs, etc. to be stored, with the idea of a Hall of Fame building in mind.
6. A Hall of Fame trophy will be presented to the last known owner and/or rider according to the APHA records. Every attempt will be made to contact these people. A duplicate trophy will be available at a nominal fee for another party who was involved as breeder, owner, or exhibitor.
7. In addition to a completed nomination form, a minimum of two and a maximum of four unique letters of recommendation from different sources are required, as well as a photograph of the nominee. These may be attached and emailed to Theresa Brown at tbrown@apha.com or mailed to her attention at PO Box 961023, Ft. Worth, TX 76161.

This form is designed to help expedite the nomination process. If you need more space, or prefer not to submit electronically, please submit it in writing on 8.5 x 11 sheets, (answering all the questions on the form) not to exceed a total of 4 printed pages. Nominations for Hall of Fame inductees will not be accepted verbally.

Nominees will automatically remain on the ballot for further consideration for a total of five (5) consecutive years, if not selected upon initial nomination. It is not necessary to re-nominate a horse during that period; however, it is suggested that updated information be provided (such as updated contact information, additional awards, etc.) After a total of (5) years, the nominee must be resubmitted for consideration.
