## START!

Are both parents (sire + dam) registered with APHA, AQHA or any international Thoroughbred registry?

Use the traditional registration procedure.



Complete the Application for International Appendix Registration. Include a copy of the horse's current registration certificate. The fee is \$40.



Use the traditional registration application. The fee is \$40. The APHA parent must be verified through genetic testing.



We're sorry. At this time, your horse does not meet APHA requirements.



Does your Paint have International Appendix Registration papers? Updating the ownership is easy! Send the original APHA certificate, transfer report, and a copy of the IR certificate showing the current owner. The fee is \$25.



Your horse may be eligible for dual registration in APHA's International Appendix Registry.
