

## 2020 NC 4-H Horse Program Virtual State Horse Show COSTUME RULES

Unless specified otherwise, [NC 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations](#) will be applied when judging the classes. Please review the GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES POST first for general rules and attire. *Please review the rules for costume class attire, as there are rules for footwear, helmets, etc.*

### **General Pattern Set Up and Filming Guidelines**

1. Follow the class' below filming guidelines. Failure to do so is grounds for disqualification. All videos must be recorded horizontally.
2. Videos must show a continuous shot, in the order listed below, and clips may not be edited together.
3. Each video should only include one "entry" for a single class.
4. Videos must begin with the camera operator, announcing the name of the class, the exhibitor's name, the horse's name, and the date.

### **Video Specifications**

1. The video begins with the camera operator announcing the name of the class, the exhibitor's name, the horse's name, the name of their costume if they so desire (example: Peter Pan and Tinkerbell; the Headless Horseman; etc.), and the date.
2. Horses must be filmed at the profile, approximately 40 feet away. Must show 30-45 seconds of the walk each direction.
3. Horse/pony/rider combo will then stop and the camera operator will show a closer view of their costume by walking around them once each direction to show closer details of the costume.
4. Filming ends for that class.
