
IEA Reining Pattern #7

Online Video Guidelines

- Videos of classes must be unedited from start to finish, including the equipment check. They must be one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible at all times.
- Videos must be filmed in LANDSCAPE orientation.
- Reining patterns must be videotaped from halfway down the left wall at the center cone.
- Keep the horse in frame, paying close attention to the near corners. You may zoom in slightly on the far corners.
- Videos must be in focus.
- As soon as the class is finished, the camera must slowly circle the horse and rider showing all equipment and attire, including spurs if used.
- IEA equipment rules apply.
- Show dress is required
- Coaching during the class is not allowed.
- The instructions for the horsemanship pattern may be called.
- The natural background sound for the test must be audible. Classes with no sound at all will not be accepted.
- The video may not be a ride from a previous show.



IEA Reining Pattern 7



Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern, beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

- Beginning on the left lead, complete two circles to the left. The first circle large and fast. The second circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
- 2. Complete two spins to the left. Hesitate.
- Beginning on the right lead complete two circles to the right. The first circle large and fast. The second circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
- 4. Complete two spins to the right. Hesitate.
- Beginning on the left lead, go around the end of the arena, run down the right side of the arena past center marker, stop and roll back right.
- Continue around the end of the arena to run down the left side of the arena past the center marker. Stop. Back up. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.
