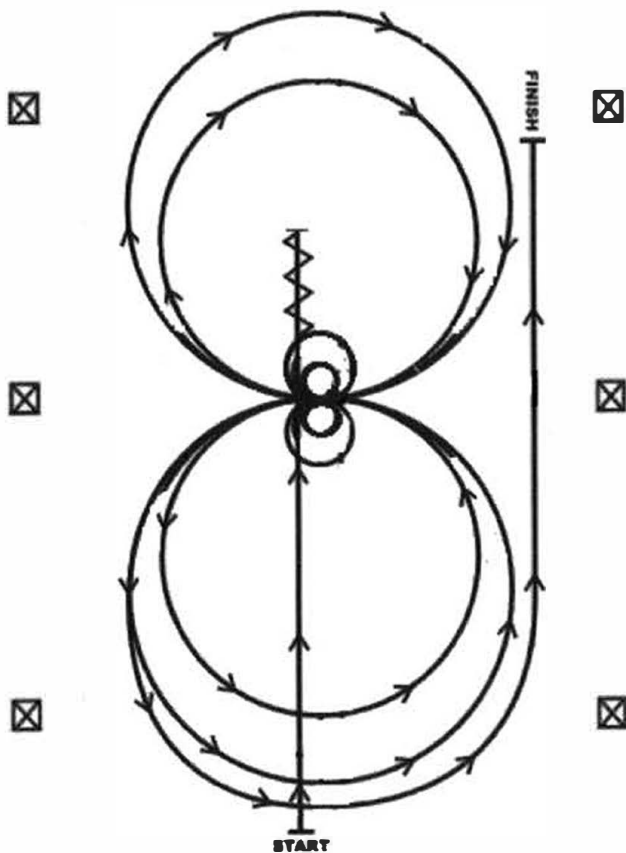
IEA Reining Pattern #1

Online Video Guidelines

- Videos of classes must be unedited from start to finish, including the equipment check. They must be one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible at all times.
- Videos must be filmed in LANDSCAPE orientation.
- Reining patterns must be videotaped from halfway down the left wall at the center cone.
- Keep the horse in frame, paying close attention to the near corners. You may zoom in slightly on the far corners.
- Videos must be in focus.
- As soon as the class is finished, the camera must slowly circle the horse and rider showing all equipment and attire, including spurs if used.
- IEA equipment rules apply.
- Show dress is required
- Coaching during the class is not allowed.
- The instructions for the horsemanship pattern may be called.
- The natural background sound for the test must be audible. Classes with no sound at all will not be accepted.
- The video may not be a ride from a previous show.

IEA Reining Pattern 1

1. Forward lope past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
2. Complete two spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Complete two and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
4. Beginning on the left lead, complete two circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Complete two circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
6. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Forward lope up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.
