

# 2020 AZ State Virtual 4-H Horse Show

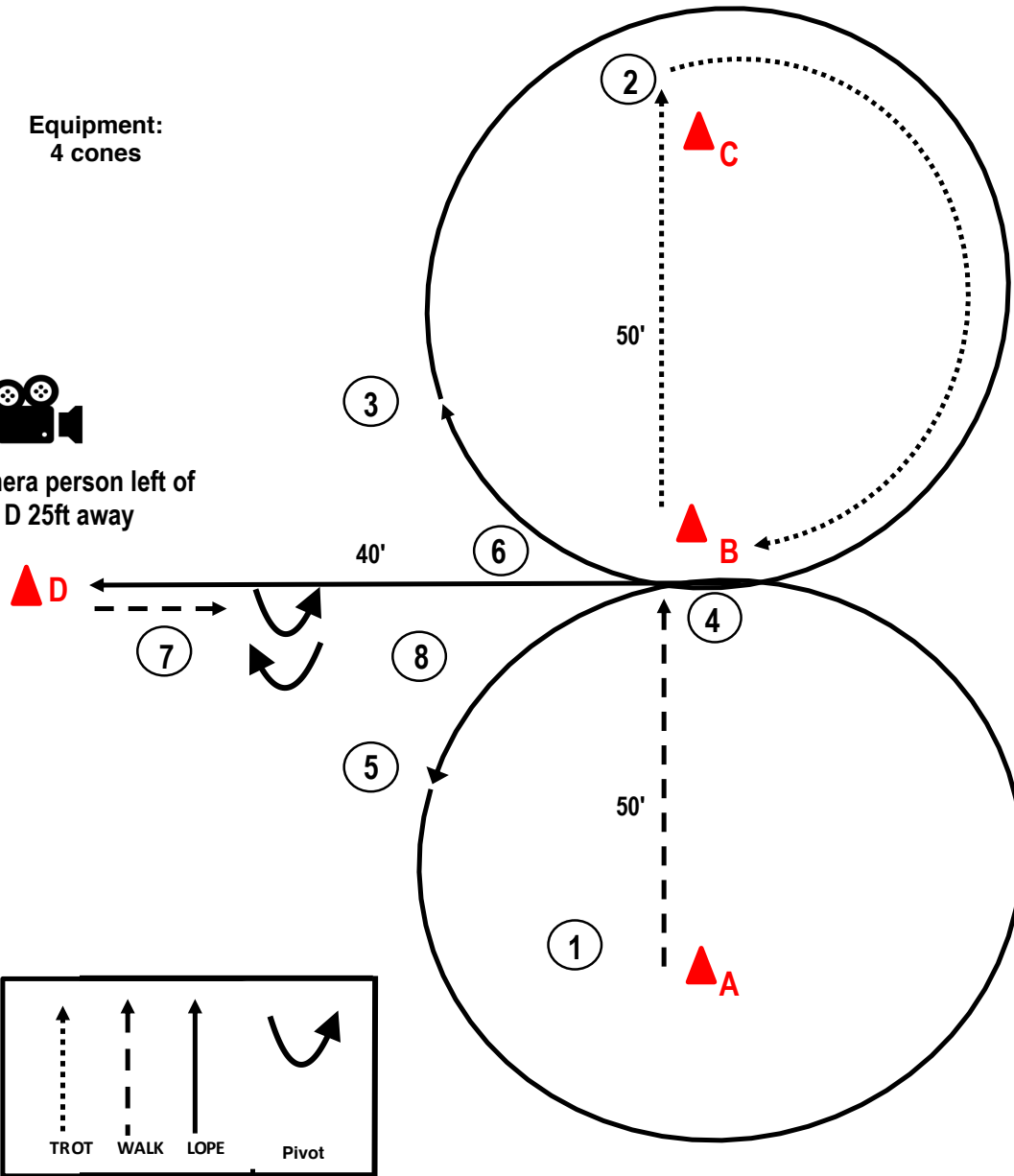
## Western Equitation



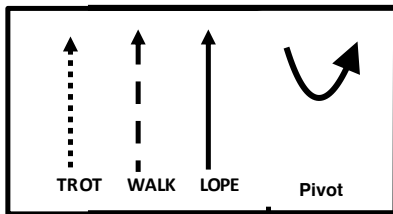
Equipment:  
4 cones



\*Camera person left of cone D 25ft away



Note: Perform your rial work in the arena before your pattern. Refer to the second page for the filming instructions. The video must be one continuous shot including both rail work & pattern.



KEY

- 1) Walk from cone A to B
- 2) Trot from B to around C & back to B
- 3) Lope one circle (right lead) around cones B, & C.
- 4) Lead change (simple)

- 5) Lope one circle (left lead) around cone A & back to B
- 6) Continue lope to cone D and stop
- 7) Back 6 steps
- 8) 180 degree pivot left. 180 degree pivot right

### Set Up

- 1) 50ft between cone A & B
- 2) 50ft between cone B & C
- 3) 40ft between cone B & D

These measurements are just suggestions and can be adjusted to fit your riding space.



## **2020 AZ State Virtual 4-H Horse Show Western Rail Video Instructions**

- Must film the profile of the horse from approximately 40 feet away
- Must film a continuous video that shows the walk, jog, and lope for 10-20 seconds at each gait in both directions, ending with a stop and back of 4-5 steps.
- No need to show any extended gaits.
